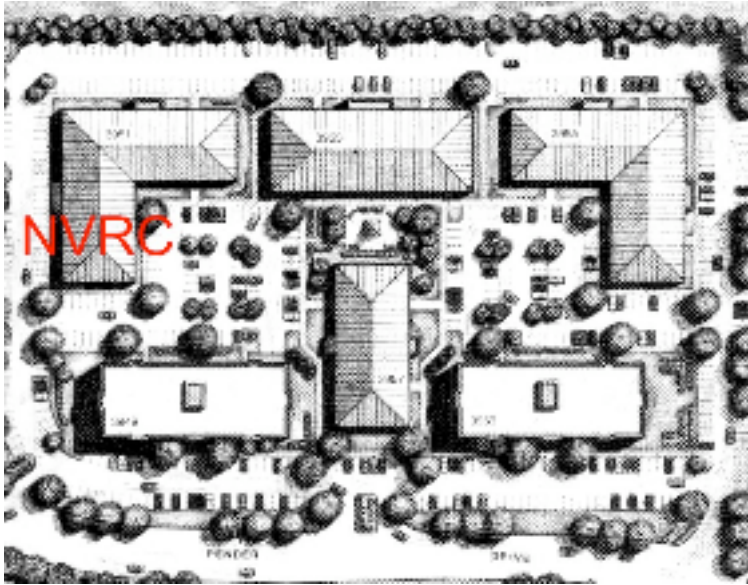

## **Directions to NVRC**

3951 Pender Drive,  
Suite 130  
Fairfax, VA 22030

FROM I-66: Take exit 57A (US 50-E) toward Fairfax. Merge onto Route 50 East, also known as Lee Jackson Memorial Highway. Turn LEFT onto Waples Mill Road. Turn RIGHT at light onto Pender Drive. Look on right for Fairfax Executive Park. Turn RIGHT at third entrance (left corner of Building 3949, a 3-story building). Drive toward back of complex and turn RIGHT

between the 3-story building and the 1-story Building, which is 3951 Pender. Parking is in the courtyard. NVRC faces the courtyard, Suite 130. There are two entrances; one side door directly into the office (sign on door) and one facing the courtyard leading into the meeting rooms (Sign on building). Handicap accessible parking spaces with ramp are near the entrance to the meeting rooms
