Mary Bagby taught a one-week “summer camp” that involved three hours a day with the kids. Mary said that was a great experience for her.

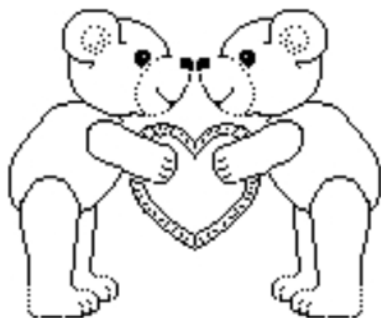

Annual General Meeting on 06-07-2010

On June 7, 2010, the annual General Meeting started with a presentation by Jason Zinza on “The Numbers Have It: ASL Acceptance Policies in United States Colleges”.

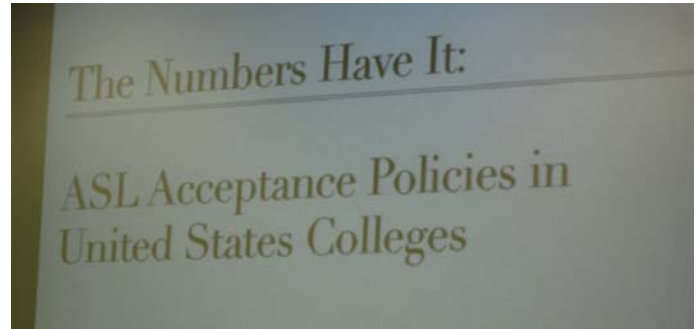
ASLTA established a task force in 2008 to investigate the status of ASL acceptance policies around the USA. This task force is called “Research in Higher Education”.

Phase 1 of the investigation had responses from 39% of 1,961 schools (approximately 700). Of those 700 responses, 58% accepted ASL (entrance & exit), while 14% didn’t accept ASL.

The task force found no pattern to acceptance / rejection of ASL policies. For instance, Ivy League and State universities (generally) accepted ASL. Reasons for not accepting ASL were: lack of literature, lack of culture, poor quality instruction, and not used around the world.

For Virginia, 8 out of 94 colleges responded to the Phase 1 survey. All of these 8 accepted ASL but College of William and Mary evaluated on a case-by-case basis. For Phase 2, the task force will contact admissions offices and get names of people who will reply to the survey.

In conclusion, the task force still has a lot of work to do, and need help from the ASLTA local chapters.

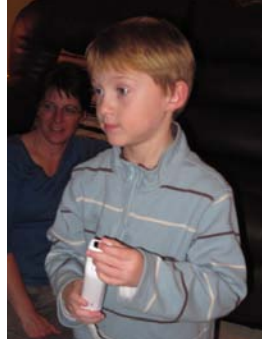

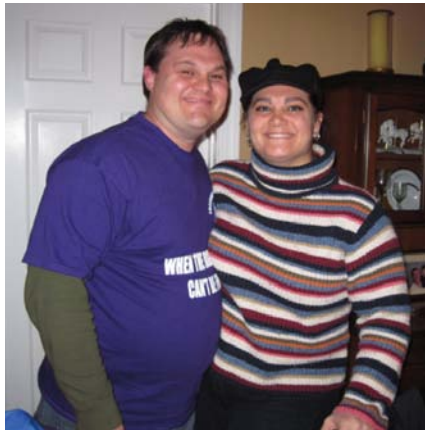

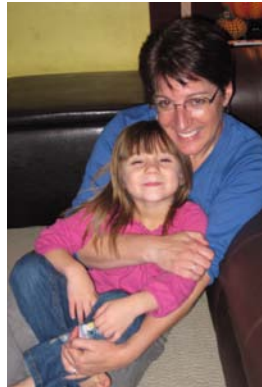

I attended the JNCL-NCLIS three-day meeting with Glenna Ashton. It was my first-time. The first day started with a welcome greeting from Dan Davidson, president of JNCL-NCLIS, and an overview from David Edwards, executive director of JNCL-NCLIS. Next was Rep. Rush Holt (D-NJ) who talked about H.R. 4065, which is to amend the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to establish a partnership program in foreign languages. That afternoon we did congressional visits. My first two visits were with offices of Senator Mark Warner (Leah Ralph, Senior Legislative Correspondent) and Senator Jim Webb (Maribel E. Ramos, Legislative Assistant). The last visit was with office of Representative Gerald Connolly (Matthew Graham, Legislative Assistant). We were to stress three key points asking for support from those offices:

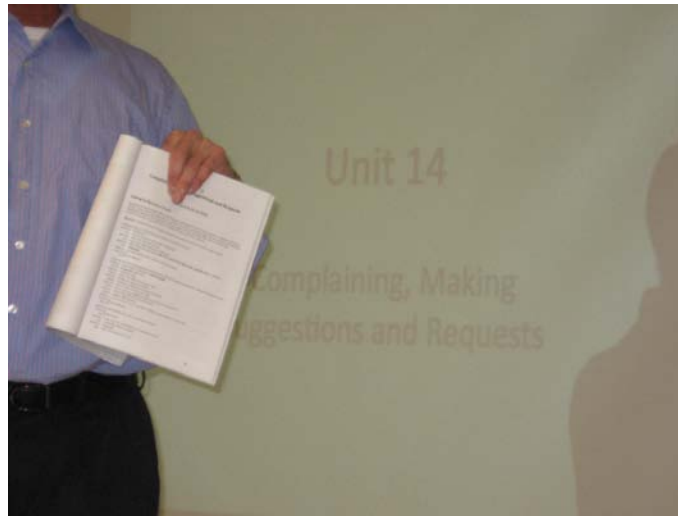
1. Foreign Language Education Partnership Program Act
2. Funding increases for foreign language education such as the FLAP (Foreign Language Assistance Program)
3. Maintain dedicated funding for Foreign Language Education

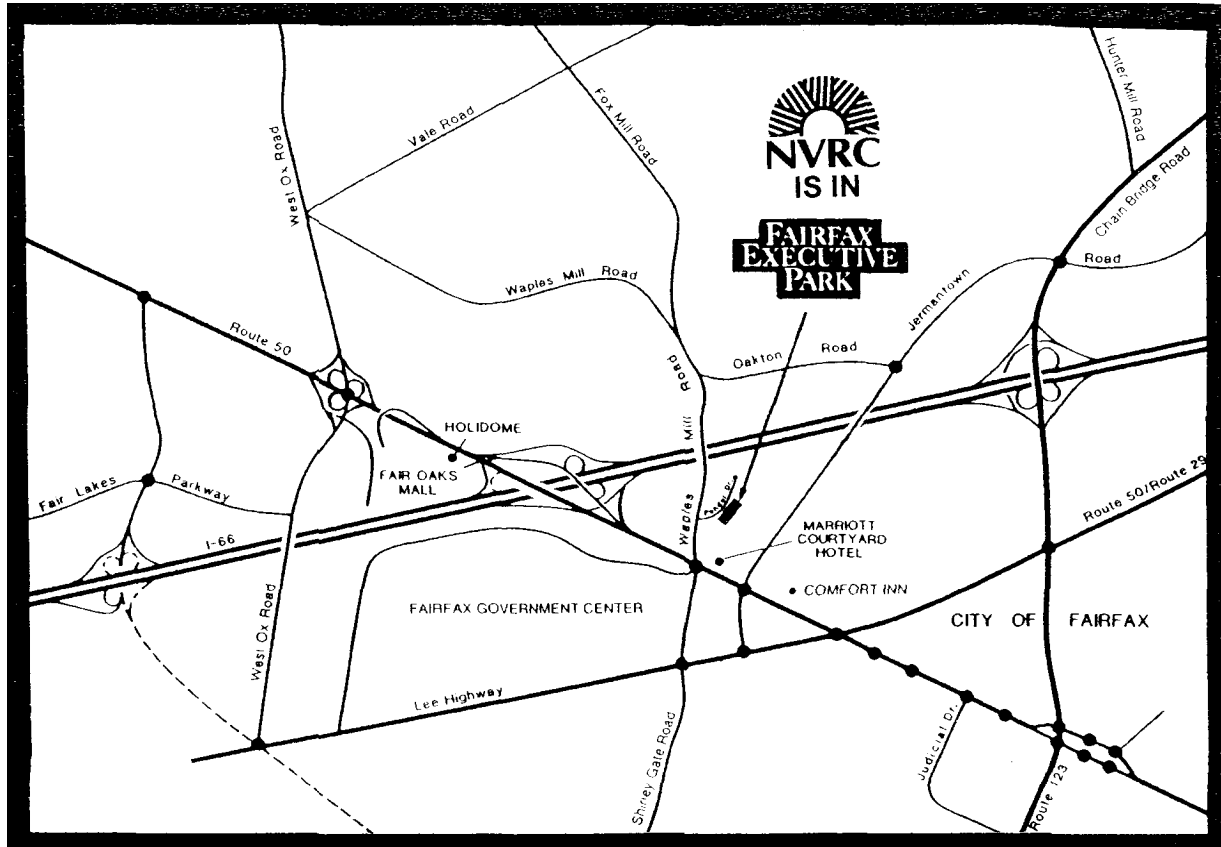

** Make a RIGHT at the 3rd sign for the "Chef's Café" (5th driveway), drive straight ahead past the 3-story building on the right. Make a RIGHT at the one-story building ahead, which is 3951 Pender. NVRC occupies the right half of that building. There are two entrances: one directly into the office and one (handicap accessible with handicap parking and ramp) directly into the meeting rooms.
